

# Information for parents enrolling students displaced by Hurricane Michael

## **Q How do I know where to enroll my student?**

We will find a place for your student(s) relocating to Okaloosa County based on your new/temporary address. Schools will immediately register students under any of the following scenarios

- Students who move into a school's attendance zone (rent/buy)
- Students who are staying in a hotel/motel in a school's attendance zone with no immediate plans to rent/buy
- Students who are living with friends or relatives within a school's attendance zone (MIS Form 5425 is required – school personnel can assist with this.)
- Students who are staying with friends or relatives outside of a school's attendance zone **ONLY IF** the students who currently live at that residence already attend that school under Controlled Open Enrollment.

NOTE: Students who move into housing in Walton or Santa Rosa Counties should enroll in those districts.

Students should be enrolled at the school that serves their new address. Parents can enter an address in our School Site Locator at <http://apps.schoolsitelocator.com/?districtcode=53757> to see which school their student should attend.

## **Q What if I am unable to provide information on my student such as immunizations, free/reduced lunch qualification, physicals, academic records, etc.?**

The more information you can provide the better, but schools can get students enrolled and begin providing services with a minimal amount of information. Please contact the school that your new address is zoned for to receive further instructions.
