- The administration reserves the right to make necessary changes based on the State of Florida Core Class-Size Requirements. The data collected in the spring dictates the purchase of teachers, supplies, and programs. Please choose your elective options carefully.
Any changes to course selections need to be made before June 21, 2021.
- A course waiver form, obtained from the elementary guidance office, must be signed if a parent desires a different course than the 5th grade teacher recommendation. Any course waiver must be attached and returned with this registration form so that classes and teachers can be assigned. Although the request will be honored, due to class size requirements, your child may have to remain in the course you selected for the entire year.
- After the beginning of the school year, I understand that schedule changes will only be considered for academic purposes after a meeting involving the student, parent, teacher, counselor and administrator.
- All high school courses taken in middle school will count toward graduation and honor graduation designation. Students who elect not to receive high school credit must withdraw from the course within the period identified by the district (for a semester course, on or before the mid-point (4 ½ weeks) of the first quarter; for a year-long course, by the end of the first nine (9) weeks), or will be given a withdrawal F.
